## APRIL 19, 2021 Free COVID-19 Vaccine for Students 16+ (Optional; RSVP Required)

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The McKinney Fire Department has offered to administer the two-dose Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine to Melissa High School students who are 16 years of age or older at the McKinney ISD Stadium vaccination site. The vaccine is optional, free of charge, and an RSVP is required in order to sign up.

- There will be two vaccination clinics scheduled three weeks apart at McKinney ISD Stadium. The first clinic will take place within the next 1-2 weeks. Further information will be communicated once available to those who have completed the RSVP.
- For students who are 16 or 17 years of age, a parent or guardian will be required to accompany the student to the vaccination clinic. Students who are 18 years of age or older do not need a parent or guardian present in order to receive the vaccine.
- Up to two accompanying parents or guardians can opt to receive the vaccine along with their student(s).
- In order for the student to receive the vaccine, either the student or the custodial parent/guardian (depending on the student's age) must complete the appropriate RSVP form, linked below, by Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at 12:00 noon.
  - <u>Students Aged 16-17 RSVP Form</u> to be completed by parent/guardian
  - <u>Students Aged 18+ RSVP Form</u> to be completed by student
