

UIL REQUIREMENTS

Athletics, Band, Cheerleading, Colorguard, & Dance

All required documentation must be completed according to the program deadline. All 7-12 grade student physicals should be dated no earlier than **May 1, 2025**.

All students in grades 7-12 who will participate in UIL band, athletics, cheerleading, colorguard, & dance for the 2025-2026 school year are required to have certain information on file with the school in order to be eligible for participation.

All required documentation must be completed in Rank One according to the program deadlines. For instructions on how to access Rank One and to complete the required information for your student, visit www.melissaisd.org/uil.
